

“GRANDMA” 4 is Up, Running and Available for Purchase!

A new feature of GRANDMA is access to an on-line version of GRANDMA.

The wait is over! The newly-revised GRANDMA 4 CD is now available for purchase.

GRANDMA (which stands for the “Genealogical Registry And Database of Mennonite Ancestry”) is a world-wide genealogical project overseen by the California Mennonite Historical Society. It is a compilation and publication of a comprehensive and expanding database of all persons descended from the so-called “Dutch/

Prussian/ Russian Low-German Mennonites” of generations past and present.

The newly-published CD, the latest update of the database, provides information on 672,293 individuals in 205,463 families. The CD comes in a new, attractive packet that includes a full hard-copy user’s manual for the first time. This user’s manual provides instructions for installing, using, and adding to the database.

A new feature of GRANDMA is access to an on-line version of GRANDMA. This brings the database into the home via the Internet for those who prefer this limited, but constantly updated, version of the GRANDMA files.

The basic cost of GRANDMA 4 is \$30. However, for the first time, purchasers have the option of “adding-on” a full registered version of “Brothers Keeper,” the preferred software that organizes the data. The combined cost of GRANDMA 4 plus a registered copy of Brothers Keeper 6, (for those who have not already purchased “Brothers Keeper” on their own) is \$75.
