

**Rod Janzen. *The Prairie People: Forgotten Anabaptists*. Hanover, N.H.: University Press of New England, 1999.**

The *Prairieleut* Hutterians, emigrating from the Ukraine in the late nineteenth century to settle on the Dakota plains, are an understudied American Christian community. While these Prairie People maintain Hutterian social and theological traditions, they have chosen, unlike other Hutterians, to live non-communally. Nonetheless, to this day many of them remain committed to consensus models of decision-making, pacifism, a simple lifestyle, and to the social dimensions of Christianity.
